All these prices include: pick-up at the airport of Santiago del Estero , transportation during the hunting days, all meals and full lodge, drinks and laundry service. The prices are on a double-room basis

***For duck hunting, lodge will be in country hotels.**

They DO NOT include: transfer from Ezeiza Airport to Aeroparque (local airport) and return, permit for bringing guns into the country; hunting

license; birdboy (\$30 per day, per person); gun rental (\$50 per day); cartridges (\$12 per box of 25); plane tickets from Buenos Aires to Santiago del Estero and return (\$400); or any kind of tips.

HOW TO BOOK AND PAY

Bookings should be well in advance by paying the total cost of the lodge. Please also send copy of passport, data of the guns that will be used during hunt, and information about arrival (date, time and airline).

The rest of the payment should be when the hunt is over IN CASH (US dollars or Euros). WE DO NOT TAKE credit cards, traveler's checks or personal checks.

Seasons:

Puma and peccary: April 1st up to September 30th

The rest of the animals: all year round

NOTE: For a high success rate in the puma hunt, 7 days minimum are required.

For the puma hunt, either male or female, a special certificate which costs \$250 is needed

For collared peccary, capybara and brocket deer, certificates cost \$150 each.

Lodge prices include food, drinks and full lodge, one guide per hunter, transfer from the airport of Santiago del Estero to San Uberto premises and return, full transportation during hunt.

They **DO NOT** include: permit to bring guns into the country (\$100 per gun); transfer from Ezeiza airport to Aeroparque; hunting license for big game and doves (\$200); hunting license for ducks (\$300); skinning, preparation of the skin and transfer of it to Buenos Aires (\$150 per trophy, except water buffalo which costs \$200); air ticket from Buenos Aires to Santiago del Estero and return (about \$500); translator (\$50); transfer from Tucuman to Santiago del Estero or return.

HOW TO BOOK AND PAY

For big game hunting, booking will be confirmed as soon as the total of the lodge is wired. Trophy fees must be paid when hunt is finished, only in cash, US dollars or Euros. We DO NOT take credit cards, travellers' checks or personal checks.
